Adventures at Home

- 1. Look through everyone's videos from the past year—if possible, together on one screen. Hold a contest to find the funniest one, the most embarrassing one, and the most artistic one. First edit your library and mark your favorites.
- 2. **Share a stash of old printed photos.** Bring out the albums! If photos are loose, empty onto a table and take turns choosing one. Parents get to tell the stories behind the photos.
- 3. Each person makes a list of all the dance moves they can think of. Pool the lists. Take turns demonstrating the moves. Find music that goes with each one (e.g. the Macarena, disco, salsa, swing, the floss, other fortnight dances....)
- 4. **Cloud Gazing.** Why should we look at clouds? To slow down and calm down, be in the present. Is that a cat dancing the salsa?
- 5. Walk to a neighbor's house together to say thank you —for whatever you can think of. It's an exercise in expressing appreciation and also building community.
- 6. **Board game revival!** Bring out the old games or try something new. What did you enjoy as a kid that you'd like to share? monopoly, battleship, charades (try winging it!) chess, scattergories, scrabble. More recommendations. Also see **Game Night** under "Fun Indoor Activities".
- 7. Random Acts of Kindness. Challenge each family member to do one-a-day over the break, whether you're traveling or not.
- 8. **Family dinner:** Everyone write down an ethnic cuisine they'd like to try making (Indian, Ethiopian, Colombian, Afghan). Choose winner out of a hat. Divide tasks (find recipe, go shopping, prep, cook, etc).

- 9. **Recount an old holiday memory.** Everyone make a recording of this memory and play all the recordings over dinner.
- 10. **Design holiday or New Year's cards** and send to friends and family. (See Where to Take a Family Portrait below).
- 11. Play volleyball with a helium balloon.
